GWINNETT COUNTY DID YOU KNOW?

- Student milestone scores dropped for District 1 schools, in 2023, Gwinnett has more schools (61) below the state standard than previous years.
- During the 2022-2023 school year, 2,268 <u>teachers</u> were either assaulted, battered, or threatened.
- In 2023, Drug and Alcohol infractions increased, battery and injury to students increased 50%; Weapons infractions increased 25%
- May 2023, 225 teachers left the district; 30% went to other districts.
- Current <u>school board members</u> acknowledged a "mostly consistent decline from 2022 to 2023" in performance.
- Teacher surveys indicate (1) they do not feel respected by students or parents (2) class sizes are unmanageable (3) students require more consequences.
